Downloading and installing the AnyConnect VPN client


In order to use CEU's private network to access library contents, you need to have a CEU account and a VPN client program running on your computer. We recommend using the free AnyConnect VPN client for this purpose.

In order to download and run the VPN client please follow the steps below.


Visit the VPN page of the CEU IT Department at the following URL:

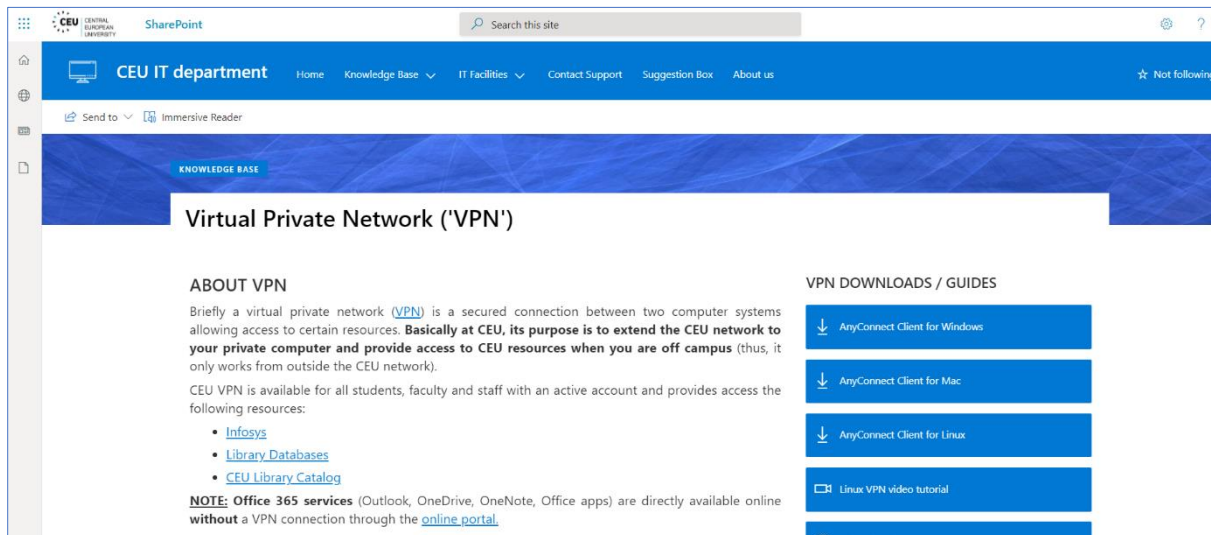
When arriving to the site you will be asked to log in with your CEU credentials. Please enter your full CEU email address, and click on „**Next**”.

Once you logged in you can see the VPN page of the IT Department.

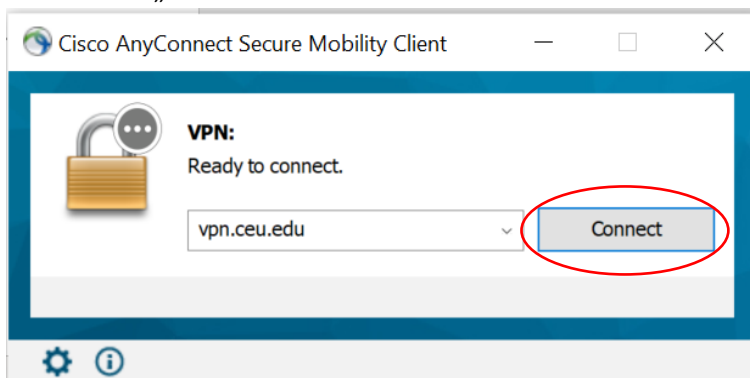

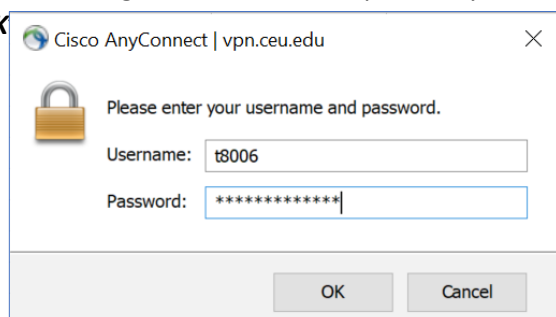
Log in to AnyConnect VPN client

Once you installed the client and set it up following the instructions on the IT Department's page, you need to log in to the VPN network of CEU.

Start the AnyConnect client on your computer. Make sure the location to be connected is set to **vpn.ceu.edu** and click on „**Connect**”.



After this a login window comes up where you have to enter your CEU username and password and click on „OK”



If you see this icon on the bottom tray, the secure connection is set.
